## Key Points

2. The butterflies and flowering dogwood trees shown in **DOGWOOD CHAPEL** have both long been cherished Christian symbols of regeneration, divine sacrifice and the triumph of eternal life.
3. **DOGWOOD CHAPEL** contains 14 N’s hidden in the painting as Thom’s tribute to his loving wife Nanette. Look closely and you will also find ducks, water lilies and Monarch butterflies enjoying the peaceful scene!
4. Thom has painted the **DOGWOOD CHAPEL** at morning, as the local villagers have gathered for morning praise and the light of God illuminates the sky and shines down upon the humble place of worship.
5. Look closely and you will find four Monarch butterflies, one for each of Thom’s daughters, in **DOGWOOD CHAPEL**.
