Reflections of Family, the second painting in the collection, is the next destination on this prayerful journey. Key Points

- The powerful themes of both reflections and family begin to emerge in the subtle details of the many animals within the painting.
- A small family of deer can be seen grazing upon the plateau and drinking from the stream. As Psalm 42:1 so perfectly states, “As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul longs after you.”
- The pair of eagles flying overhead calls to the mind the words of Isaiah 40:3 - “But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength, they shall mount up with wings like eagles.”
- There are three ducks within the work. A male and female are swimming among the cattails and the third nearly blending completely into the background.
- Hidden throughout the painting is a family of bunnies, four to be exact. Can you find them all?
- The thunderous waterfall seen in the distance is the setting of the third painting in the *Places of Reflection* series and the final destination of this spiritual journey. It reminds us that with deeper commitments come greater revelations.
